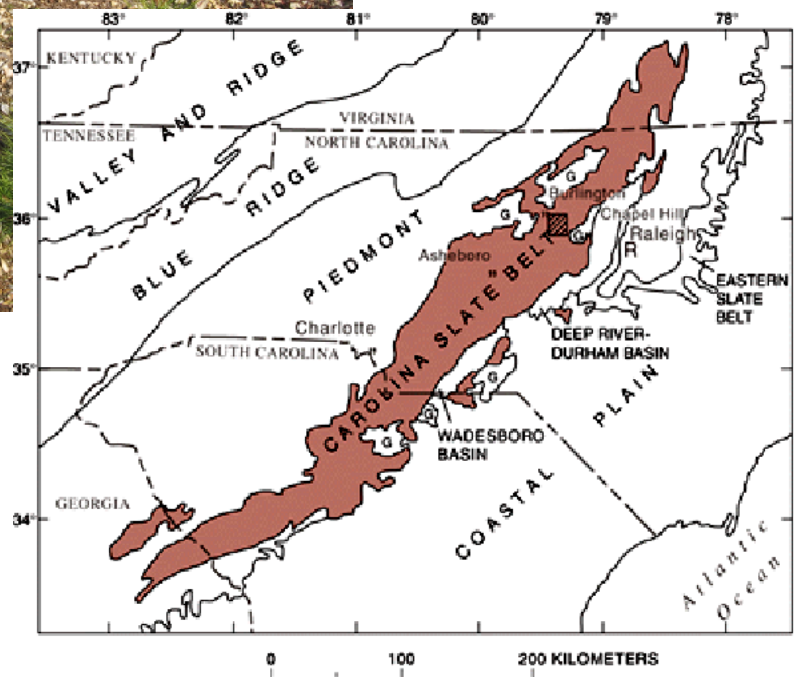
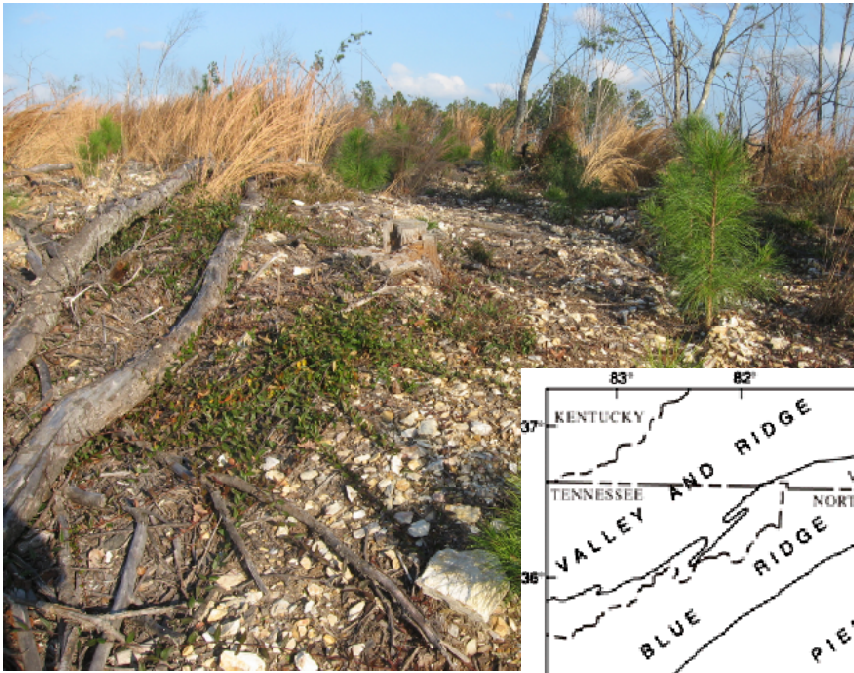


Stone Quarries and Sourcing in the South Carolina Slate Belt

The Savannah River Archaeological Research Program (SRARP) is seeking information from local landowners and artifact collectors on the location of prehistoric metavolcanic stone quarries in the South Carolina Slate Belt region.
